

Global Brigades offers 7-day Human Rights Brigades throughout the year in Panama. Human Rights Brigades primarily work with rural communities that are under-resourced and largely unaware of their own legal rights. Throughout the week, Human Rights Brigades volunteers shadow Panamanian lawyers to provide pro-bono legal consulting to rural communities. A free legal clinic provides opportunities for volunteers to not only receive experience with Panamanian legal professionals but also experience first-hand justice and the culture of legal misinformation in rural communities.

In order to be able to participate in the brigade to Central America or Ghana offered by Global Brigades USA, Global Brigades UK, Global Brigades Ireland, Global Brigades Switzerland, Global Brigades Germany, Global Brigades Canada, Fundacion Brigadas Globales de Panama, Global Brigades Ghana, Asociacion Global Brigadas de Honduras, or Fundacion Brigadas de Nicaragua (hereafter collectively referred to as "Global Brigades"), I hereby agree to the following conditions:

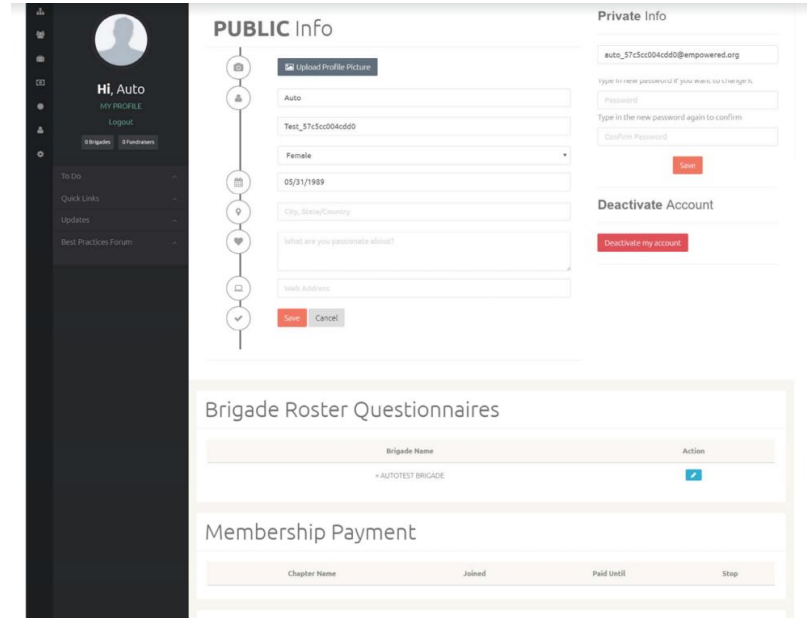
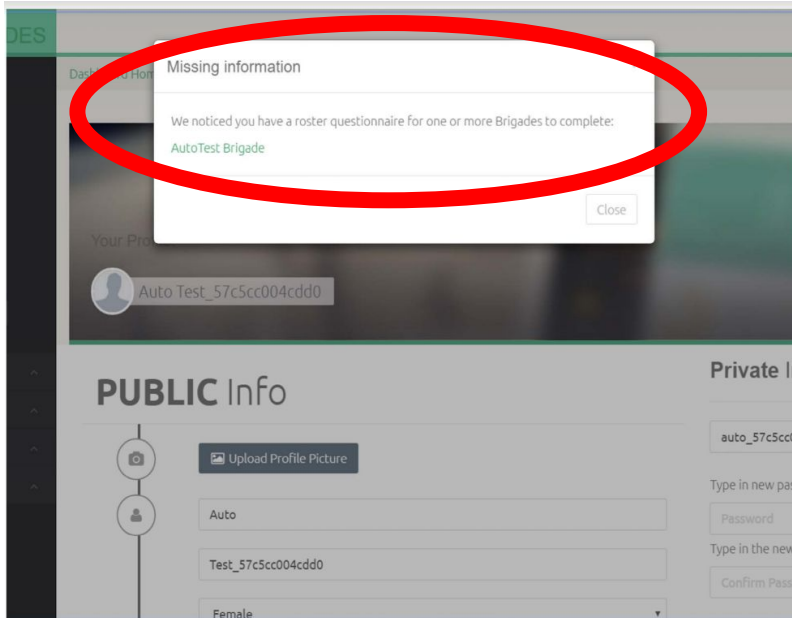

## Deadlines



- **Initial Donation Goal Deadline (October 15th, 2019):** Volunteers must raise **\$250** on their fundraising page to secure their spot on the brigade and to begin flight booking!
  - The sooner EVERYONE has their \$250 in, the sooner we can book flight and the cheaper those flights will be!
- **Travel Donation Goal Deadline (December 15th, 2020):** Anyone on the group flight will have to fundraise the full amount of their airfare by this deadline. (Approximately \$250)
  - There will be a preliminary deadline **November 15th, 2020** for an additional \$250
- **Final Donation Goal Deadline (February 15th, 2020):** Volunteers must have the total Donation Goal + airfare on their fundraising page.
  - There will be a preliminary deadline **January 15th, 2020** which will be about half the final donation goal price
